

Youth Newsletter Update Both Fuel and Refuge are going strong every Sunday. Fuel meets from 5:00 to 6:30 and Refuge runs from 7:00 to 8:30. With our middle schoolers, we have just begun a new series called "The Whole Story". It is a look at the book of Genesis – first showing how even today they are a real and vibrant masterpiece in God's awesome creation and later showing how Jesus has been there with us since the very beginning. In Refuge, we have just started a series on the book of Malachi called "Empty Religion or Vibrant Faith". We are studying how Israel was simply going through the religious motions and giving God their leftovers as opposed to giving God all he deserves and fostering a real relationship with their creator – and how often we are guilty of the same in our lives. We have stopped Sunday school until May 20th to offer our communicants class. We have a great group of 8 elementary to middle school aged students who have begun the process of becoming members of our church!
